THE TITHE

You may have heard the term "tithing" to describe giving to church. But what is a tithe? "Tithe" means "a tenth" in Hebrew, and it comes from the biblical exhortation that God's people were to give 10% of their produce (grain, materials, etc.) back to God as an act of worship and a way to ensure that everyone in the community had enough. Today, our produce is equated with our income, and the tithe is a standard for helping us consider how we might be generous with what we have as an act of thanksgiving for God's provision in our own lives.

We encourage you to consider the tithe and its relationship to your journey of discipleship-- how you prioritize and allocate your time, your talent, and your treasure.

TIME

Did you know that the average person has approximately **5,840** waking hours in a year? That means that even if you attended church and formation hour *every Sunday* for an entire year you would only spend about **3%** of your time in church.

We invite you to consider how you might stretch your time commitment to God in this next year, whether that be through attending church more often, joining a Bible study, volunteering at a parish event or two, or even carving out some time for daily prayer/Bible reading.

HOW TO GIVE

WHAT IS PLEDGING?

Pledging is an act of spiritual intention. It is not a binding contract, but rather a means for prayerfully considering one's financial offering each year.

WHY IS PLEDGING IMPORTANT?

By making a pledge to St. Richard's, you enable us to plan ahead and set our own annual budget.

HOW MUCH SHOULD I GIVE?

How much you should give is between you and God. Though the biblical standard is the tithe, giving 10% of your income (net or gross) might be a bit of stretch for you at this season in your life. That's ok. The point of our financial stewardship is not to meet an arbitrary benchmark, but rather to grow in faithfulness and generosity as followers of Jesus. Begin with what you think you can comfortably give, and then consider giving just a percent or so more. Every single gift really does make a big impact, helping us reach our goal and fulfill our common mission.
